Dear President Davis,

On behalf of the Anti-Defamation League's (ADL) Pacific Northwest Office, I write to you again today to express our deep concerns over the situation unfolding at Linfield University, in which we first wrote on April 8, 2021.

We acknowledge your response to our letter. In light of continued media reports of additional allegations of antisemitic remarks attributed to you, faculty no votes of confidence, and continued lack of accountability on the part of the University's leadership, we believe that a change in leadership is in the community's best interest at this time. We urge you to consider resigning as President and allow the community to heal and determine the necessary next steps for the University and greater community.

We remain deeply concerned by the lack of transparency and accountability by University leadership over the alleged pattern of antisemitic comments and the hurt that is has caused to the Jewish community. Now is the time to begin the process of moving forward and healing on campus and in the wider community.

We hope to be able to work together to build a campus environment in which all are safe, included and have the equal opportunity to thrive.
